- Working in teams, participants conduct an environmental audit in order to identify a suitable eco-project focusing on; transport, energy saving, sustainability, green energy and recycle, reduce and reuse
- The project management process will include checking the viability of their chosen project, planning, implementation and calculating the costs and benefits in terms of both money and for environment
- Ongoing support and help with identifying funding can be provided, for more ambitious projects, through follow up visits
